



Safety Plan Covid 19- Level 3

Purpose:

To mitigate the risk of transmitting COVID-19 at school during Alert Level 3

Prime responsibility:

The Principal

Level 3 planning:

- review readiness using MOE 'School Readiness Checklist'
- review property using MOE 'Property Checklist for Schools' – reopening after COVID-19 Alert Level 4
- limited return to school by students; will be accommodated in the School Library
- majority of staff to continue working from home
- ensure that sufficient staff are at school to meet the needs of those students returning
- students returning to school will be placed in pods for the duration of Level 3
- students – those at home, those at school continue to engage in distance learning
- ensure social distancing protocols are maintained in practice
 - 2m spacing in class and in playground. Students and staff will need to learn these practices.
 - No touching other students learning resources, stationery, equipment, foodstuffs, clothing
- Ensure good hygiene practices are discussed, reinforced and practiced
 - handwashing with soap
 - use of hand sanitiser
 - coughing into elbow
- ensure good cleaning practices are discussed, reinforced and, practiced
 - regular disinfecting of high touch areas
 - rigorous daily schedule of cleaning
 - ensure ongoing supply of cleaning resources
- maintain high levels of communication that helps:
- ensure that at risk staff and students remain at home
- ensure that 'sick' staff and students remain at home
- have in place a 'Contacts Register'. Every person on site is required to fill this in daily
- work with bus contractors to ensure safe travel to/from school
- in the advent of someone at school feeling ill and exhibiting symptoms of Coronavirus we will immediately contact health officials for advice Health line 0800 358 5453 or Tuapeka Health Centre 485 9050
- evaluate effectiveness of school COVID-19 practices at the end of each school week.
