



## SPORT POLICY

### **Rationale**

1. To enable students to enjoy recreational activities; individually or as team members.
2. To develop social interaction skills, game knowledge and fitness.
3. To develop positive sporting attitudes where participation, enjoyment, sportsmanship and safety are paramount.
4. To encourage excellence in a student's chosen sport.

### **Guidelines**

1. The school will endeavour to provide a wide range of sporting activities within the school environment and within the community, using school facilities and resources.
2. The school will provide all students with the opportunity to participate in sport regardless of ability, race or socio-economic status.
3. Players are responsible for paying individual subscription fees.
4. The school will ensure that students:
  - a. wear PE uniform with school tracksuits provided
  - b. have access to appropriate equipment
  - c. are provided with appropriate coaching and/or supervision
5. The school follows the Fair Play Scheme produced by the Hillary Commission which aims to develop integrity, fairness and respect for the opposition, team mates and umpires in all sporting activities whether competitive or social.
6. The principles and practices of Fair Play in Sport will be promoted within the Physical Education programme.
7. All coaches, administrators and sporting officials within the school community will be familiar with the Fair Play principles.
